Through a special program of the Morning Star Chinese Academy and Atlanta Professional Dance Academy, Hand in Hand offers a unique opportunity for children adopted from China to learn about the Chinese culture through bilingual language and Chinese dance classes.

Language

The language class is based on conversational Chinese, so the emphasis is on speaking and understanding. We enforce vocabulary and concepts learned in class through Chinese songs and games.

The classes will be divided by age and whether the kids have had any previous language background.

Classes will be taught by teachers from the Morning Star Chinese Cultural Center



Culture

The classes have culture based themes that change every month and class activities are centered around them. Themes may include Chinese musical instruments, holidays, calligraphy, arts and crafts, and games.

Dance

Chinese dance class will be taught by teachers from the Atlanta Professional Dance Academy.

The dances will be modern Chinese children's dances to popular music from China.



Big Sisters and Brothers

The Big Sisters and Brothers Program is a great way for kids to meet Chinese big sisters and brothers and learn about the Chinese culture. We hold monthly events usually on Saturday afternoons, and the kids develop very close relationships with their mentors.

Language and dance students are automatically a part of the Big Sister Program.



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
